

## Course Description

Both the 5K and 10K courses wind down Upper Bear Creek, with a finish near Evergreen Lake. This course treats participants to one of the most scenic and fastest races in Colorado. In fact, this may be one of the best races you will ever run! The fastest 5K ever run in Colorado was run on this course - 14:07 by Jason Hubbard in 1998.

## Race Schedule

- 6:30 a.m.- Registration Opens
- 6:30 a.m.- Buses start for 5K
- 7:15 a.m.- Buses start for 10K
- 9:00 a.m.- 5K Awards
- 10:00 a.m.- 10K Awards

## Transportation

Free bus transportation will be provided to the start line.

**5k:** buses for the 5k event depart from Evergreen High School until 7:30 a.m.

**10k:** buses for the 10k event depart from the Xcel Energy frontage road until 8:00 a.m.

*You must display your race number to get on a bus. No one without an official number will be allowed on the buses. Upper Bear Creek Road will be closed to all traffic and there will be no parking available at the starts.*

***If you miss the bus, you miss the race.***

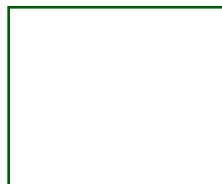
## Race Beneficiary

- Top male and female wheelchair entrants.

\*Age groups: 12 & under (5k only); 13-19; 20-29; 30-39; 40-49; 50-59; 60-69; 70-74; 75 & older.

## Timing Chips & Bib Pick up

Timing chips will be attached to racer bibs. Champion Chip and other brands of chips are non-compatible with the timing system. Racer bibs can be picked up at per-determined locations (locations and timing to be announced on our website at: <http://www.evergreentownrace.org/> ) OR the morning of the race at the bus pick-ups.

## Directions

### To Evergreen High School (for 5k):

**From Denver via I-70 west:** Take exit 252 (Evergreen Parkway) to Colorado 74. Go south 7.8 miles to traffic light just past lake. Turn right on Hwy 73. ½ mile to traffic light at Buffalo Park Rd. Turn right and go 0.7 miles. The 2<sup>nd</sup> entrance goes to the parking lot used for the race.

**From Denver via 285 south:** Exit onto North Turkey Creek. Go 6.2 miles to T. Turn right onto Hwy 73. Go 3.3 miles to traffic light at Buffalo Park Rd. Turn left and go 0.7 miles.

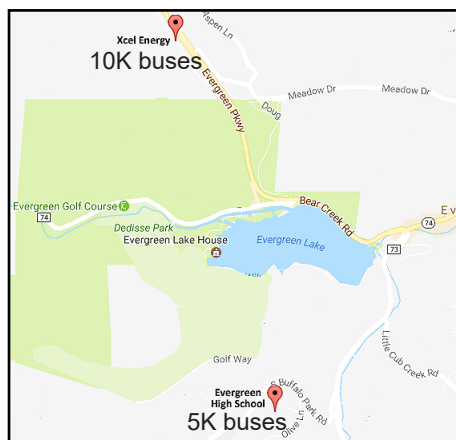
**From Conifer at 285:** Exit onto Hwy 73 for 8.75 miles to traffic light at Buffalo Park Rd. Turn left and go 0.7 miles.

### To Xcel Energy Frontage Road (for the 10k):

**From Denver via I-70 west:** Take exit 252 (Evergreen Parkway) to Colorado 74. Go south 6.5 miles.

**From Denver via 285 south:** Exit onto North Turkey Creek. Go 6.2 miles to T. Turn right onto Hwy 73. Go 3.85 miles to T at the 2<sup>nd</sup> traffic light. Turn left on Colorado 74. Go 1.3 miles.

**From Conifer at 285:** Exit onto Hwy 73 for 8.75 miles to T at the 2<sup>nd</sup> traffic light. Turn left on Colorado 74. Go 1.3 miles.
